Employee Rights Under the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute

Vandenberg SFB civilian employees are currently represented by one of the following organizations certified by the Federal Labor Relations Authority as the exclusive representative:

Employees with bargaining unit status (BUS) codes of 7777 or 8888 are not represented by a labor organization. BUS code 7777 indicates that an employee is eligible but not in a bargaining unit. BUS code 8888 indicates that an employee is ineligible for inclusion in a bargaining unit.
